Kanji- stands for Harmony, representing the integration of Okinawan, Chinese and Korean martial arts and philosophies that make up our system.

Laurel Leaves- represent peace and serenity and the resolution of conflict without fighting, the highest level of martial arts training.

Yin and Yang- has its root in Chinese philosophy and reminds us to keep balance in our life and represents the balance of hard/soft techniques in our art.

Dragon- is a benevolent and mythical creature from Asia. The Red Dragon represents power, passion, good fortune and is viewed as a symbol of our natural world.

Hangul- reads Tong Che Bahk Do, the name of our art.
